Who doesn't have a question in their heart about what is coming on the earth? It seems as though we are reaching a climax of events, bringing to us yet another shift away from the world we once knew. Our lives and our freedoms that we took for granted in the fall feasts of 2019 have now disappeared forever into the maelstrom of iniquity which appears to be overcoming the earth. Shall we howl and wail?

Let it not be so, but let us be strong and courageous, embracing the world as it is set before by the mighty hand of Yahuah, who guides and directs us. There are those who will run in fear; others who will endlessly prep with food and supplies; and others who will repress all knowledge of things by any means, including drugs, alcohol, compulsive overeating, or even by simply denying all reality.

The leadership of the world is lost now - they don't know what to do, or even how to think. They reach conclusions based on sheer insanity that somehow sacrificing children will appease their angered god, or that should they embrace the extermination of vast amounts of people they will be righting the over-population problem. None of them seek the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Instead, they impose their views on the world, asserting themselves as elohiym, and demanding not only compliance, but the utterance of the blasphemy they commit. And these very same people have built their Deep Underground Military Bases where they intend to hide from the coming wrath of Yah. The ingathering feasts however, call upon the children of Yashar'el to practice the rhythm of life which was ordained by Yahuah in the beginning. This year, as it has been for the last several years, the need to properly observe these feasts is upon us as much will be coming on the rebellious, god-hating world. Many are saying sudden destruction; others are saying financial collapse (using the "crash" word). The diviners in the world are saying many things, but scripture is not of private interpretation. Virtually all of the prophets of scripture have pointed to these times.

And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; 26 Men's hearts fail-ing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. 27 And then shall they see the Son of A'dam coming in a cloud with power and great glory. Let us first restore to us the true Elohiym, Yahuah Tseva'oth is his name, and abandon all Ba'ali worship and the sacrifices to Molech, that we might be clothed in white linen before our judge, our lawgiver, and our king. 

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The Fall Feasts of Yahuah

13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love Yahuah Elohaykem, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul, 14 That I will give you the rain of your land in his due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your grain, and your wine, and your oil. 15 And I will send grass in your fields for your cattle, that you may eat and be full. 16 Guard yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other elohiym, and worship them; 17 And then Yahuah's wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heavens, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and lest ye perish quickly from off the good land which Yahuah gives you.

When we look to Yahuah for our provision, we must undertake two things:

To hearken diligently to the commandments of Yahuah, to love Yahuah Elohaykem, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul
To guard yourself from having your heart be deceived, causing you to turn aside, and serve other elohiym, and worship them;

Molech is the wicked king – the king of shame and derision Letting your seed pass through to Molech includes:

- Declaring allegiance to a king (or state) which declares itself sovereign above Yahuah
- Passing citizenship under such a king (or state) to your children
- Allowing and participating in the usurpation of the Ten Devariym by the Molech state
- Placing your children in the care of the Molech state
- Replacing the commandments, statutes, and judgments of Yah with the law of the Molech state

What does it mean to serve other elohiym?

The assertion of the false deity – the god/man/king on the throne of Molech calling himself (or herself) Ba'ali (Lord and Master) will seek to separate the believer from the tree of life and to leave them hanging on the tree of good and evil.

It can therefore be expected that the Molech state would promote a man lying with another man as with a woman; that the state would promote a woman lying down with a beast; - that the state would advance *confusion*.

The Molech state in asserting its authority over the authority of Yahuah will go on then to exceed all of the Ten Devariym:

- The state will create engraved images of itself that requires worship
- The state will demand fealty to its name and banner
- The state will establish itself as "father" under the doctrine "parens patriae"
- The state will establish the work week and its tenets

The Molech state in asserting its authority over the authority of Yahuah will go on then to exceed all of the Ten Devariym:


- The state will kill its enemies, foreign and domestic (its essential nature)
- The state will commit political adultery, whoring after other gods and nations
- The state will steal anything and everything from anyone and everyone
- The state will license itself to bear false witness as needed
- The state will practice and encourage covetousness

16 Guard yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other elohiym, and worship them; 17 And then Yahuah's wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heavens, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and lest ye perish quickly from off the good land which Yahuah gives you. Yet, when the state asserts itself over all matters of human relations as the Molech state, the citizens thereof worship a different elohiym and are under *his law*.

Shâneh (שְׁנֶה) H8141 (in plural or (feminine) (שְׁנָה) Shânâh; from H8138; a year (as **a revolution of time**):— whole age, long, old, yearly.

The heavens enumerate the glory of El; and the expanse shows his handywork. 2 Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night shows knowledge. 3 There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. 4 Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. Tequphat (הָקוּפַת) H8622 from H5362; *a revolution*, i.e. (of the sun) course, (of time) lapse: *circuit*, come about, end.

H5362 (נָקָף) Nâqaph, a primitive root; to strike with more or less violence (beat, fell, corrode); by implication (of attack) to knock together, i.e., surround or circulate:—compass (about, -ing), cut down, destroy, go round (about), enclose, round.

16 And the Feast of Qatsiyr, the first fruits of your labors, which you have sown in the field: and the Feast of Aciyph, which is in the end of the year, when you have gathered in your labors out of the field. Shemoth (Exodus) 23:16

Aciyph is now spelled out that it is at the end of the year *when you have gathered in your labors out of the field*. Is this said about the Feast of Tabernacles?

The feast of Aciyph appears to be a feast which contemplates the year end and consequently the beginning of the cycle of the next year. It is not dependent on a new year (Rosh Ha'Shanah), but rather is finalized *when you have gathered your labors out of the field*.

Let us then consider the latter rain.

13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love Yahuah Elohaykem, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul, 14 That I will give you the rain of your land in his due season, **the first rain and the latter rain**, that you may gather in your grain, and your wine, and your oil. 15 And I will send grass in your fields for your cattle, that you may eat and be full.

A teaching rain [מוֹרָה] Môwreh H4175 from H3384; (see H3138) an archer; also, a teacher or teaching; also, the early rain:—(early) rain.

H3384 אָרָא Yârâh, yaw-raw' or (2Ch 26:15) אָרָא Yârâ'; a primitive root; properly, to flow as water (i.e., to rain); transitively, to lay or throw (especially an arrow, i.e., to shoot); figuratively, to point out (as if by aiming the finger), to teach:—(+) archer, cast, direct, inform, instruct, lay, shew, shoot, teach(-er,-ing), through. *The same root of the word Torah*.

A latter rain [מַלְקוֹשׁ] Malqôwsh, from H3953; (compare H3954) the spring rain; figuratively, eloquence:—latter rain.

H3953 לְקַשׁ Lâqash, a primitive root; to gather the after crop:—gather. *M'laqash means from the gathering of the crops.*

So, the moreh [מוֹרָה] is the teaching rain of the fall and includes all of the feasts of fall which together are called Aciyph. This includes the high feasts of Yahuah, namely, Yom Teruah (the Feasts of Trumpets), Yom Kippuriym (the Feast of Atonement), and Cukkot (the Feast of Tabernacles).

These feasts are now upon us, and in this year, each of these feasts have a prophetic calling for the children of Yashar'el.

Let's take a look.
