Into the Wilderness

31 Behold, the days come, says Yahuah, that I will cut a Renewed Covenant with the house of Yashar'el, and with the house of Yahudah: 32 Not according to the covenant that I cut with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Mitsrayim; which my covenant they broke, although I was a husband unto them, says Yahuah: 33 But this shall be the covenant that I will cut with the house of Yashar'el; After those days, says Yahuah, I will put my Torah in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their Elohiym, and they shall be my people. 34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying: Know Yahuah: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, says Yahuah: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

7 For thus says Yahuah; Sing with gladness for Ya`aqov, and shout among the chief of the nations: publish ye, praise ye, and say, O Yahuah, save your people, $\pi\lambda$ the remnant of Yashar'el. 8 Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the coasts of the earth, and with them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and her that travails with child together: a great company shall return thither. 9 They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a Father to Yashar'el, and Ephrayim is my firstborn.

10 Hear the Word of Yahuah, O ye nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say: He that scattered Yashar'el will gather him, and guard him, as a shepherd his flock. 11 For Yahuah has redeemed Ya`aqov and ransomed him from the hand of him that was stronger than he. 12 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Tsiyon, and shall flow together to the goodness of Yahuah, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow anymore at all. 13 Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, both young men and old together: for I will turn their mourning into joy, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow. 14 And I will satiate the soul of the priests with fatness, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, says Yahuah.

10 And in that day, there shall be a root of Yishai, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the other nations seek: and his rest shall be glorious. 11 And it shall come to pass in that day, that Adonai shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Ashshur, and from Mitsrayim, and from Pathroc, and from Kush, and from Eylam, and from Shin`ar, and from Chamath, and from the islands of the sea. 12 And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Yashar`el, and gather together the dispersed of Yahudah from the four corners of the earth.

2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of Yahuah's house shall be established in the top of the mountains and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. 3 And many people shall go and say: Come ye and let us go up to the mountain of Yahuah, to the house of the Elohai of Ya`aqov; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Tsiyon shall go forth the Torah, and the Word of Yahuah from Yerushalayim. 4 And he shall judge among the nations and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore. 5 O house of Ya`aqov, come ye, and let us walk in the light of Yahuah.

Yesha'yahu (Isaiah) 2:2-5

5 For thus says Yahuah; We have heard a voice of trembling, of fear, and not of peace.

6 Ask ye now, and see whether a man travails with child? Wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness? 7 Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the time of Ya`aqov's Trouble; but he shall be saved out of it. 8 For it shall come to pass in that day, says Yahuah Tseva'oth, that I will break his yoke from off your neck, and will burst your bonds, and strangers shall no longer serve themselves of him: 9 But they shall serve תא Yahuah Elohayhem, and תא David their King, whom I will raise up unto them.

10 Therefore fear you not, O my servant Ya`aqov, says Yahuah, neither be dismayed, O Yashar'el: for, lo, I will save you from afar, and your seed from the land of their captivity; and Ya`aqov shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make him afraid. 11 For I am with you, says Yahuah, to save you: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered you, yet will I not make a full end of you: but I will correct you in measure, and will not leave you altogether unpunished.

Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah) 30:5-11

21 But I had pity for my holy name, which the house of Yashar'el had profaned among the heathen, whither they went. 22 Therefore say unto the house of Yashar'el: Thus says Adonai Yahuah; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Yashar'el, but for my holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went. 23 And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am Yahuah, says Adonai Yahuah, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. 24 For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land.

25 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. 26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new ruach will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my Ruach within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall guard my judgments, and do them. 28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be my people, and I will be your Elohiym.

29 I will also save you from all your uncleanness: and I will call for the grain, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you. 30 And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that ye shall receive no more reproach of famine among the heathen. 31 Then shall ye remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations. 32 Not for your sakes do I this, says Adonai Yahuah, be it known unto you: be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Yashar'el. 33 Thus says Adonai Yahuah; In the day that I shall have cleansed you from all your iniquities I will also cause you to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be built. 34 And the desolate land shall be tilled, whereas it lay desolate in the sight of all that passed by. 35 And they shall say: This land that was desolate is become like the Garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities are become fenced and are inhabited. 36 Then the heathen that are left round about you shall know that I Yahuah build the ruined places, and plant that that was desolate: I Yahuah have spoken it, and I will do it.

11 In that day will I raise up the cukkah of Daviyd that is fallen and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old: 12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, says Yahuah that does this. 13 Behold, the days come, says Yahuah, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that sows seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt. 14 And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Yashar'el, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens and eat the fruit of them. 15 And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, says Yahuah Elohayka.

Amoc (Amos) 9:11-15

21 And say unto them: Thus says Adonai Yahuah; Behold, I will take the children of Yashar'el from among the heathen, wherever they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land: 22 And I will make them one nation in the land upon the mountains of Yashar'el; and one King shall be King to them all: and they shall be no more two nations, neither shall they be divided into two kingdoms anymore at all: 23 Neither shall they defile themselves anymore with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their Elohiym. 24 And David my Servant shall be King over them; and they all shall have one Shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and guard my statutes, and do them. 25 And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Ya`aqov my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children forever: and my Servant David shall be their Prince forever.

26 Moreover I will cut a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them forevermore. 27 My Tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their Elohiym, and they shall be my people. 28 And the heathen shall know that I Yahuah do sanctify Yashar'el, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them forevermore.
